16.15 Performance: “Loose ends hiding in kitchen” by Gloriya August

Loose ends hiding in kitchen drawers” (2021) is a performance which guides the audience into a non-linear narration that unfolds a self, situated in the crevice between the pressing body of memory and a yearning that continuously flexes its course. Artist statement: Gloriya August’s multidisciplinary practice explores the interplay between the social, physical and sen-

sible spaces that inhabit us. Borrowing language from daily encounters – from content found online to everyday interactions – she seeks to engage personal experiences that are fundamental facets of our selfhood. Her writing often pours over into other mediums in the forms of drawings, objects and performances, multiplying into myriad reflective surfaces in which we might recognize ourselves and our place in the world.
